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**WHAT IS THIS PRODUCT?****TYPE**

**OBJECTIVES**

The Fund aims to achieve capital appreciation by investing its assets mainly in shares listed in Spain and Portugal. The Fund's investments in shares will be made without restriction to the market capitalization of the company.

The Fund will be actively managed and the Investment Manager, Bestinver Gestión, S.A. S.G.I.I.C., will discretionarily choose how the Fund is invested. However the referenced benchmark is formed by the following composite index: 90% IBEX 35 and 10% PSI 20. The Fund aims to outperform its benchmark over a period of 3 years.
